White was eastern correspondent for the Galveston Daily News in the 1870's. Holdings include correspondence, clippings, calling cards, scrapbooks, printed miscellanea, and an 1805 stock certificate from the Baltimore and Frederick-Town Turnpike Road. Of special interest to Galveston are manuscript letters from Richardson, Belo and Company, publishers of the Galveston News and the Dallas News to White concerning harbor improvements and letters from Robert B. Talfor, brother-in-law of White, written while engaged in surveys for U.S. Engineers in New Orleans and Galveston, 1874-75.
