PAPERS, 1819-1930; 2½ inches, MS.

Personal papers and some business records of Pierre Gautier, a native of France who became a merchant, confectioner, and liquor dealer in Mexico City, Tampico, and Matamoros, Mexico, and of his son Achille Gautier (1845-1924) who relocated the business to Galveston in 1865 when the Civil War blockade of this port was lifted.

Papers are correspondence, bills, receipts, memoranda, exchange notes, consignment certificates, news clippings, and an instrument of protest.

Places associated with the papers are Mexico City, Tampico and Matamoros, Mexico; Galveston, San Antonio, San Patricio County, and Brazoria County, Texas; New Orleans; Paris, Bordeaux, Le Havre, Perigueux, France; Los Angeles; St. Louis.
