Thomas Dunbar Affleck, Sr., 1880-1966, a native of Washington County, Texas, was a resident of Galveston from 1913 until his death. He engaged in business in the city as a cotton broker and real estate agent. Affleck was also a local historian of note and served as vice-president of the Galveston Historical Society when it was organized in 1942.

Papers include letters, notes, clippings, trial balances, cablegrams, shipping receipts, statements, and bills of lading of the business of Marcel Baudoux and Company and A. Verbeke and Company, cotton exporting firms.
