Organized in 1919 and active past World War II, this was one of several political factions strong in the city during the 1920's and 1930's. Supporters of Galveston City Party were firm in their opposition to municipal ownership of the Galveston Wharves. Among their number were many of the leaders of the Galveston Wharf Company, including the Sealy and Kempner families.

Papers include election notices, platform statements, press releases, correspondence, and news clippings.
