Mostly the papers of Victoria Williams Campbell, a Galveston school teacher, and her two daughters, Alice Campbell and Elizabeth (Bessie) Fowler Campbell. Victoria was the second wife of Andrew Monroe Campbell, who moved from Tennessee to Texas in 1851, and settled near Columbus, Colorado County. Although he owned over 30,000 acres of land, Andrew went bankrupt after the Civil War, and his first wife died. He then married Victoria Williams of Columbus and moved to Galveston, serving as a partner in the firm Campbell & Clough, commission merchants.

Alice and Elizabeth were each married twice, Alice to Albert Sidney Johnson and district attorney Aubrey Vance Fuller, and Elizabeth to James E. Galbraith and Marcus Cato McLemore, Jr. In this collection, the papers of both daughters have been filed under their maiden names for convenience. Alice and Albert Sidney Johnson had a son, Robert Dabney Johnson, who died as a young man.

A map of the burnt district in Galveston following the 1885 fire has been transferred to the Map File, #395B.

Reference should also be made to the oversize shelf (for an autograph book belonging to Victoria Williams Campbell), Special Collections #62 (which includes portrait photographs of the family members), and Eleanor Harrison Saunders book, The Campbell Family with Allied Families.
