In October 1987, the Mayor and City Council of Galveston appointed the Leadership Galveston Alumni Association to formulate a master plan for the city's 150th anniversary.

The plan called for the formation of a Galveston Sesquicentennial Commission, to be comprised of fifteen members to be appointed by the City Council. Tim Kingsbury was selected as executive director. The Commission planned events beginning with a party honoring Galveston's 150th birthday, March 4, 1989, and culminating in a San Jacinto Day event, "A Celebration of Galveston and the Texas Heroes Monument," April 21, 1989.
