These scrapbooks contain clippings of newspaper articles by Joseph Osterman Dyer (1856-1925) on Galveston history, Native Americans, and other subjects. One scrapbook contains loose material regarding the King's Highway (El Camino Real or Old San Antonio Road), including two letters and printed matter from Mrs. Lipscomb Norvell. The other scrapbook has a laid-in copy of Dyer's Corrected and Epitomized Lessons of Texas History, Part I, Period of 1518 to 1807.
