Edna Seinsheimer Levin is the daughter of Mr. & Mrs. Fellman Seinsheimer, Sr. and the granddaughter of Mr. & Mrs. Joseph Seinsheimer. She was the first recipient of the Galveston Historical Foundation's Founders Award. While her husband, Dr. William C. Levin, served as President of the University of Texas Medical Branch (1974-1987), she was known as the First Lady of UTMB for her many functions and activities. With her help, the Faculty Women's Club was reorganized and reactivated. Board appointments include: The Grand 1894 Opera House, GHF Advisory Board, Temple B'nai Israel, President of the Temple Sisterhood, Public Health Nursing Service Board, Leticia Rosenberg Old Women's Home, the Junior Welfare of Galveston, and the American Red Cross.

The collection includes five notebooks containing guest lists, menus, and planning notes for her almost fifty years of hosting social functions. (Oversize MSS# 95-0017) The notebooks also contained loose materials which have been arranged and processed. These include printed invitations, entertainment contracts, correspondence with personal friends and caterers, receipts, and more planning notes.
