Papers of Valerie Grimbaum Wechsler (1902-) , her husband Edward Wechsler (1895-1973), and her brother-in-law Richard Marco Wechsler (1907-1992). The Wechsler family immigrated from Austria in 1939 and settled in Galveston in 1940. Valerie Wechsler operated an antique shop and was active in the Young Women's Christian Association and Beta Club, which are reflected in her papers.
