According to Galveston city directories Antonio "Tony" Venson (1873-1962) worked as driver for various companies 1899-1921. He also worked for the Galveston Houston & Henderson Railroad as a driver from 1923-1947. His obituary reflects his love of sports reporting that he once played with the Old Indian Scalpers, a semi-professional baseball team, and was an umpire and treasurer for the City Baseball League for approximately 25 years.

His papers consist mainly of property records for Outlot 35, SE 1/4, Lot 1 which was his residence at 3727 Avenue N 1/2. He was married to Masona Venson and they had three sons, Charles, Robert and Edward, and one daughter, Mrs. W. E. Dunlap.

He participated in some function with the Pirate Soccer Club. A photograph of him was transferred to the photo collection's name file.

E. Venson may have been Edward Venson, a son of Antonio and Masona Venson.
